# *Dept. of Defense Wants You To Hack the Pentagon...Repeatedly*

The Defense Department plans to make Hack the Pentagon-style bug bounty challenges available in a new contract vehicle.

The department contracted HackerOne and Synack to create a contract vehicle that allows DOD components and services to launch such competitions to discover and remediate website vulnerabilities.

Though tech companies have long used bug-bounty programs to root out security issues, the Pentagon and the Defense Digital Service experimented with it for the first time in the spring. The numbers of Hack the Pentagon are impressive: 1,400 vetted hackers tested five websites, 138 unique vulnerabilities were found and fixed, and it cost \$150,000 with about half going to pay the participants. The department said hiring a contractor for similar efforts would have cost about \$1 million. [Click for Link to story](#)

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## *New PA Laws Benefit Veterans*



Two new laws, passed by the General Assembly and signed by the governor, seek to help veterans start their own businesses or ease their tax burden.

[Act 135 of 2016](#), known as "Startups for Soldiers," will waive state business startup fees for individuals transitioning to the civilian workforce from the United States Armed Forces, including reserve units and the National Guard.

[Act 117 of 2016](#) will eliminate veterans' disability payments from income eligibility under the Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program starting in 2018. This will allow more veterans to qualify for the program, which offers rebates on rent and property taxes for senior citizens and those with permanent disabilities.

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## *GSA to Offer Cloud-Based Contract Writing System Next Year*

The General Services Administration will offer a new service to federal agencies next year designed to speed up contract writing.

[According to a Blog Post \(click here\)](#) published this morning, GSA will launch a cloud-based shared service contract-writing system that will "offer federal agencies a turnkey, comprehensive, contract writing and administrative solution."

The commercial-off-the-shelf application will offer agencies an incentive to move away from standing up and maintaining their own contract writing systems, and its pay-as-you-go offers scalability and flexibility, according to GSA. In addition, high-volume users are eligible for tiered volume discounts through GSA's buying power.
